

Review C564:2011 Mobile Phone Base Station Deployment Industry Code

I object to any changes that will have a detrimental impact on the public.

I refer you to WORLD, HEALTH ORGANIZATION 'Setting the standard for a wireless world of harm' by Olga Sheean (30 January 2017)

- No public access to archival information about showing radiation increase over time (Radio Frequency National Archive).
